**DAM REHABILITATION AND IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (DRIP)**  
**PHASE II AND PHASE III**  
**GENERAL PROCUREMENT NOTICE**

The Government of India *has applied for* financing from the World Bank (International Bank for Reconstruction and Development) toward the cost of the DRIP Phase II and Phase III, and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for goods, works, related services and consulting services to be procured under this project. The duration of Project is ten years, to be implemented in two Phases, each of six years duration with two years overlapping.

The project will include the following components

1. Rehabilitation and Improvement of Dams and Associated Appurtenances: This component envisages physical rehabilitation of proposed dams to address the various safety concerns including need based de-silting of few dams etc.
2. Dam Safety Institutional Strengthening: This component has the provisions for activities related to institutional strengthening, publication of guidelines/manuals, emergency action plans, operations & maintenance manuals, updation and implementation of Dam Health and Rehabilitation Monitoring Application (DHARMA), infrastructure support, public outreach programs, CS&QA activities, risk assessment of selected dams, management information systems etc.
3. Incidental Revenue Generation for sustainable operation and maintenance of dams: It has the provisions for activities to explore long term sustainability of operations & maintenance of existing dams, through incidental revenue generation through innovative ideas i.e. development of tourism, fisheries, secondary sources of power generation (hydel as well as solar), water recreation activities etc.
4. Project Management: This includes the support to PMUs for the activities related to procurement of goods and services, consultancy services, outsourcing of supporting staff, day to day management of project activities, meetings, conferences etc.

Procurement of contracts financed by the World Bank will be conducted through the procedures as specified in the World Bank's *Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers* dated July 2016, revised November 2017 and August 2018, setting forth the World Bank's policy, and is open to all eligible bidders as defined in the regulations.

Prequalification of suppliers and contractors may be required for major contracts under works. Specific procurement notices for contracts to be bid under the World Bank's international competitive bidding (ICB) procedures and for contracts for consultancy services will be announced, as they become available, in UN Development Business, e-procurement site government of India (<https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>), official web site([www.damsafety.in](http://www.damsafety.in)), national and local news papers.
