These documents can be made part of official proposals.

Annexure-IV Clarification no. 3, Sr No 9	<p>Under Column '4' Corresponding Cost has been mentioned,</p> <p>The corresponding cost refers to the Cost of similar assignments as per the six categories. The bidder is required to furnish the financial value of the Contract that has been executed by the firm against the category mentioned in Section-I of the REOI. It is not the Project Cost but the Consultancy fee.</p>	<p>We understand that the corresponding cost is the total consultancy fee of the assignment executed by the consultant.</p> <p>Generally, Project Cost is based on various parameters as exist at the time of bidding project as per TOR issued by client and need not be exactly in same format as requested by you.</p> <p>Reclassifying them as 6 categories as per your TOR may not be always possible. However, we can surely indicate which categories are covered in that assignment.</p> <p>We therefore request that we shall indicate in each Project Data Sheet, the various categories covered along with total consulting fee. 5.	Expression of Interest	Last date/time for receipt of bid through e-procurement is on July 20 ,2020 upto 1500 hrs (IST).	We request you to kindly extend the date of submission by at least 4 weeks from current date of submission i.e. from 20th July, 2020 to 20th August 2020 due to prevailing Covid conditions in the world.	<p>As per the World Bank procurement Regulations, it prescribes 10 business days for responding to REOI, however, CWC has given 60 days for responding to REOI keeping in view ongoing global pandemic COVID19, which seems reasonable for getting adequate participation of foreign bidders.</p> <p>There is still three weeks' time for last date/time for receipt of bid through e-procurement. However, based on the outcome of the Pre-REOI meeting appropriate action would be taken by CWC in this regard.</p>
